Citizen Charter

Patient Rights

A patient has the right to:-

- respectful care given by competent personnel.
- upon request, to be given the name of his attending physician, the names of all other physicians directly participating in his care, and the names and functions of other healthcare persons having direct contact with the patient.
- every consideration of his privacy concerning his own medical care program. Case discussion, consultation, examination, and treatment are considered confidential and shall be conducted discreetly.
- have all records pertaining to his medical care treated as confidential except as otherwise provided by law or third-party contractual arrangements.
- 5. know what hospital rules and regulations apply to his conduct as a patient.
- 6. expect emergency procedures to be implemented without unnecessary delay.
- good quality care and high professional standards that are continually maintained and reviewed.
- 8. full information in layman's terms, concerning his diagnosis, treatment, and prognosis, including information about alternative treatments and possible complications. When it is not medically advisable to give such information to the patient, the information shall be given on his behalf to the patient's next of kin or other appropriate person.

Patient Responsibilities

Patient has the responsibility to...

- provide information about present and past illnesses, hospitalizations, medications and other matters relating to his/her health history.
- have members of his/her family authorized to review his/her treatment, if he/she is unable to communicate with doctors or nurses.
- formulate an advanced directive and appoint a surrogate to make healthcare decisions on his/her behalf, to the extent permitted by the law.
- 4. ask questions if he/she does not understand directions or procedures.
- help his/her doctor, nurse, and healthcare support staff in his/her efforts to care for his/her by following their instructions and medical orders.
- report safety concerns immediately to his/her doctor, nurse, or any healthcare support staff.

- ask for pain relief when pain first begins and tell his/her doctor or nurse if his/her pain is not relieved.
- avoid drugs, alcoholic beverages or toxic substances, which have not been administered by his/her doctor.
