

Dhanwantari Apex Trauma Centre: Pt. B.D. Sharma, PGIMS, Rohtak

The Dhanwantari Apex Centre was established under the aegis of Pt. B.D. Sharma postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak in January 2018 to provide life saving emergency surgical care and treatment to victims of trauma under one roof.

The DATC has a state of art centrally air-conditioned building with its own oxygen supply plant and engineering units (PWD & Public health and electrical). There is provision of an independent reception area, triage area with capacity of 20 hospital beds and 16 ICU beds, operation theatre with 5 OTs, ICU with capacity of 21 ICU beds and ventilators, Counselling room and ward with capacity of beds.

It also has a dedicated radiology wing which provides X-Ray, Ultrasound, CT-scan and MRI services to victims of Trauma without any delay in the same premises. There is an independent laboratory for provision of various tests required for the patients, run jointly by Pathology, Microbiology and Biochemistry departments.

DATC is dedicated to provision of comprehensive health care to all the needs of trauma victims under one roof. It acts as a one stop centre for provision of emergency services from surgery, orthopaedics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Neurosurgery, Cardiology, Plastic Surgery and other super speciality services at one point.

Considering the fact that victims are usually accompanied by next of kin there is provision of a separate air-conditioned attendant waiting area with all basic amenities.
