

College of Nursing, Pt. B. D. Sharma, PGIMS, Rohtak

Department of Nursing was established as School of Nursing in the year 1964 with an annual intake of 30 students which was raised to 70 students in 1973 to provide diploma in "GENERAL NURSING AND MIDWIFERY" course in a span of 3 years.

The school of Nursing was upgraded to College of Nursing in 2003 with an annual intake of 60 seats. It was later raised to 75 in 2010 to provide the degree "B.Sc. Nursing" course in a span of 4 years.

Post Graduate course in nursing was started as "M.Sc. Nursing" in 2010 with an intake of 10 students which was later raised to 30 students in 2016. The institute has Post graduation course in all five specialties i.e. Medical Surgical Nursing (10), Community Health Nursing (5), Child Health Nursing (5), Mental Health Nursing (5) and Maternal and Obstetric Nursing (5).

Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course was started as a bridging course from diploma to degree in 2014 with an annual intake of 30 students.

Nurse Practitioner- Critical Care Residency Course was started in 2018 with an intake of 15 seats.


Now the College has 450 (UG & PG) students. College is headed by Prof. Santosh Hooda (Officiating Principal), under overall administrative control of the Director, Pt. B. D. Sharma, PGIMS, Rohtak.

Achievements of the College are as follows:

1. College has acquired PG degree, post basic degree and UG degree status from a diploma level school.
2. College has independent building with fully furnished offices, lecture theatres, classrooms and laboratories.
3. 100% faculty members are postgraduate, one is Ph.D holder and eight are pursuing Ph.D. also.
4. College routinely organises workshops, seminars and others extracurricular activities for faculty members and students.
5. College students and faculty members actively participate in the various university programmes and duties assigned by the authorities with full zeal and enthusiasm.
6. Ph.D in Nursing has also been started from session 2019-20 with an intake of 2 seats and in session 2020-21 with an intake of five seats in each speciality.

At present there are 26 faculty members in the college (18 regular and 8 CDC), while the sanctioned seats as per Haryana Govt. are 42.

- During Covid-19 period College of Nursing have played a major role in serving the Covid patients.
- College of Nursing have deputed 200 students with all teachers for management of the Covid work.

The Indian Citizen of following categories will be eligible to appear in common entrance examination for admission to B.Sc. Nursing, BPT/B.Sc. Optometry/B.Sc. in Medical Technology Operation Theatre (OT)/ B.Sc. Medical Lab. Technology (MLT)/ B.Sc. Perfusion Technology/ B.Sc. Radiotherapy Technology/ B.Sc. Radiography & Imaging Technology Courses in Govt. Institutions and State Quota seats of Private Institutions:-

i) The candidates, who are bonafide residents of Haryana as per instructions issued by the Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana Chandigarh vide letter No.62/1795-6GS1 dated 3.10.96, U.O. No. 62/27/2003 - 6 GS1 dated 29.07.2003 and submit relevant certificate of bonafide residents as laid down in letter no.22/28/2003-3GS-III dated 30.1.2004.

ii) The children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of the employees of Indian Defence Services/Para-Military Forces belonging to Haryana State at the time of entry into service as per their service record. (Such candidates will submit a certificate from the Officer duly authorized by the Army/Navy/Air Force/concerned Para-Military Forces Headquarters, as the case may be).

iii) The children/wards (if parents are not living)/ dependents of Ex-employees of Indian Defence Services/Para-Military Forces belonging to Haryana State at the time of entry into service as per their service record who retired from service on or after first April of the preceding year of admission. (Such candidates will submit a certificate from the Officer duly authorized by the Army/ Navy/Air Force/concerned Para-Military Force Headquarters, as the case may be).

iv) The children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of Ex-employees of Indian Defence Services/Para-Military Forces belonging to Haryana State at the time of entry into service as per their service record, provided the candidate has studied 10+2 as a regular candidate in a recognized institution in Haryana. (Such candidates will submit a certificate from the Officer duly authorized by the Army/Navy/Air Force/concerned Para-Military Forces Headquarters, as the case may be and also a certificate to the effect that he/she has studied 10+2 as a regular candidate in a recognized institution in Haryana from the Principal/Head of the Institution last attended.

Note: The above conditions do not apply in case of Private Institutions for Management quota seats.

B. The candidates should also fulfill the FOLLOWING minimum conditions to appear in the Entrance Examination for both Govt. & Pvt. Institutions:-

(i) She/he will attain the age of 17 years or more on till the date of admission.

Note: The age shall be determined as per entry in the Matriculation/Higher Secondary or its equivalent Certificate.

C. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:-

I. B.Sc. Nursing

The candidate must have passed Senior School Certificate examination (10+2) of Board of School Education, Haryana or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least 45% aggregate marks for General Category, 40% marks for SC/BC in Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English (P,C,B & E) taken together in qualifying examination. However, the candidate must obtain pass marks in each subject separately. 10

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR POST BASIC B.Sc NURSING-2 YEARS COURSE

(i) He/she will attain the minimum age of 21 years on till the date of admission.

Note: The age shall be determined as per entry in the Matriculation / Higher Secondary or its equivalent certificate.

(ii) The candidate must have passed following examinations:

Passed the higher secondary or Senior secondary or intermediate or an equivalent Examination recognized by the university for this purpose. Those who have done Matric / 10+1 in or before 1986, will be eligible for admission.

(iii) Has obtained a certificate in General Nursing and midwifery and Registered as RN&RM with any state nurses registration council.

(iv) Must have been declared medically fit by the competent Medical Board constituted by PGIMS, Rohtak.

(v) In case of an employee of State Govt./UISR, the candidate desirous to seek admission will have to obtain an NOC from State Government/ University of Health Sciences, Rohtak before submitting their application for admission in the course. Any application submitted without NOC of competent authority will not be considered eligible for various benefits under this policy.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR M.Sc. NURSING-2 YEARS COURSE

Eligibility & Duration of Course:

(i) He/she must attain the minimum age of 22 years on till the date of admission.

Note: The age shall be determined as per entry in the Matriculation/Higher Secondary or its equivalent certificate.


(ii) The candidate must have passed following examinations:

(a) Must have passed B.Sc. Nsg. / B.Sc. Hons. Nsg. / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks from any College of Nursing recognized by Indian Nursing Council.

(b) However, in case of SC/ST/BC category candidates having 50% marks in aggregate may be allowed to appear in the Entrance Exam.

(c) Must be registered Nurse & registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.

(d) Must have Minimum one year of work experience of institute recognized by INC after Basic B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Nursing Honors or must have Minimum one year of work experience of recognized institute after or prior to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing. The work experience will be calculated from the date of registration in parent Council till the last date of submission of form.
