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Other Departmental Activities:

The department has urban and rural field practice areas which are being used for teaching, training and research activities related to undergraduate medical students, interns and Post Graduate students.

1. Urban field practice area attached with the two units of the department are being served by health workers (MPHW/MPHS) along with PGs of the department under supervision of Senior Residents and faculty members of the department for providing OPD services, MCH services, Immunization services, implementation of National Health Programs and referral services to the population. Ranbir Singh OPD Complex) of the institute during OPD hours. The department is also providing anti-rabies vaccine for animal bite cases, free of cost to all those who attend the clinic on all working days.

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
